David Nolan Morrissey is an advocate with Spina Bifida and international disability programs consultant. From 2009 through 2017 he served as the Executive Director of the United States International Council on Disabilities (USICD), where he represented Americans with disabilities in foreign affairs matters and co-led the campaign for U.S. ratification of the CRPD. In 2010 he served as a private sector advisor to the United States official delegation to the UN Universal Periodic Review of the U.S. human rights record. Previously, he was the Disability Policy Fellow with the Association of University Centers on Disabilities (AUCD). He holds a Master of Public Service degree from the University of Arkansas Clinton School of Public Service. David has been a member of the Expert Working Group on Spina Bifida Transition at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and currently serves on the board of directors of the Spina Bifida Association.
